VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

BOX OFFICE: The box office is located at the Victor Richardson gates on the Eastern side of the stadium and will open from 3pm on the day of the show only. However, to avoid queues on the day of the show patrons are encouraged to collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketek outlet.

ENTRY GATES: Concert patrons should refer to the gate number printed on their ticket for entry details.

DISABLED ACCESS: Access for mobility-restricted patrons is available through the Victor Richardson Gates.

CLOAKROOM FACILITIES: Cloakroom facilities will not be available at this event. Prohibited items may be confiscated, so if in doubt leave it in the car or at home.

PASS-OUTS: Will not be available, so ensure that you take everything that you require into the concert upon arrival.

FIRST AID: Will be available on site.

TOILETS: Will be located at various positions around the stadium.

ATM/EFTPOS FACILITIES: ATMs with limited amounts of cash will be available, however, we would encourage you to come prepared with enough money for the entire evening.

SMOKING: Smoking is prohibited in all parts of the venue complex except for designated areas. No smoking is permitted on the field itself, and cigarettes are not available for sale at the venue.

BAGS: Bags may be subject to a random safety and security search upon entry. Any prohibited items will be confiscated.

WEATHER: The concert will proceed rain or shine. Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance, so be prepared for either scenario.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE CONCERT

RECOMMENDED ROUTE: Patrons are strongly recommended to use public transport for the event. Please note that the concert will finish before the last public transport services leave the city.



BUS & TRAIN SERVICES: There are a number of bus stops along Pennington Tce, King William Rd and War Memorial Drive that are in close proximity to the venue. The nearest train station is located on North Terrace, approximately a ten-minute walk from the venue.

TAXIS: The pick-up and drop-off area for taxis will be on King William Road at the end of Victor Richardson Drive.

PARKING FACILITIES: There is limited parking available around Adelaide Oval and in the surrounding streets, however, parking is available in the North Car Park and Pinky Flat Car Park for \$15 per car. North Car Park access is via Pennington Tce (opens midday), while Pinky Flat Car Park can be entered off War Memorial Dr. (opens 4pm).

DROP OFF/PICK UP POINT: A drop off/pick up point will be located at the end of Victor Richardson Rd (near the taxi rank).

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

For a full list of the venue's conditions of entry contact Adelaide Oval. Please note that conditions are subject to change without notice and may vary from event to event.

PROHIBITED:**

- Long chains or spikes of any nature
- Offensive weapons of any kind, bottles, poster tubes or containers of any nature
- Umbrellas, tarps and blankets
- Professional cameras (with detachable lenses), video cameras, or audio recorders with external microphones as well as digital recorders
- Any object that may be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, fireworks, etc
- Alcoholic beverages
- Illegal substances
- Cans and glass (containers, bottles, glasses etc). This includes all bottles that have previously been opened.
- Flares and fireworks
- Loud hailers
- Umbrellas and sun/rain shelters
- Laser pointers
- Animals (guide dogs excepted)
- Offensive attire
- Hard eskies of any size/type (including foam eskies)
- Items that may cause a hazard or compromise safety, or that have the potential to cause injury, nuisance or inconvenience to any other patrons
- Non SACA approved cup holders

** Please note that prohibited items will be confiscated. If in doubt, leave it at home or in your car.

PERMITTED:

- Small personal cameras and camera phones are allowed. Professional cameras with detachable lenses are not.
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sealed plastic bottles of water

FIXER FIELD - GENERAL ADMISSION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Children 15 years and under must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

Field Area is not recommended for children under 12 years.

Stadium terms and conditions of entry and restricted items apply.

Patrons must enter through the gate listed on their tickets.

Dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, stage diving, crowd surfing and climbing are not permitted.
