VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

BOX OFFICE: The box offices are located at Gates 1, 3 and 4 and will open from 4.15pm on the day of the show only. However, to avoid queues on the day patrons are encouraged to collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketmaster outlet. Visit ticketmaster.com.au and check the 'Outlet Locations' page for details.

ENTRY GATES: Patrons with Fixer Field general admission tickets will enter through Gate 1. Backspacer and Reserved seating ticket holders should enter through Gate 3 or 4.

DISABLED ACCESS: Access for mobility-restricted patrons is available through all gate entry points.

CLOAKROOM FACILITIES: Cloakroom facilities will not be available at this event. Prohibited items may be confiscated, so if in doubt leave it in the car or at home.

PASS-OUTS: Will not be available at the event, so ensure you take everything that you require into the concert upon arrival.

FIRST AID: Will be available on site.

TOILETS: Will be located at various positions around the stadium.

ATM/EFTPOS FACILITIES: ATMs and EFTPOS terminals will NOT be available at the venue, so please ensure that you come prepared with enough cash for the entire evening. The closest ATM is located at the Caltex service station on Bulwer St.

SMOKING: ME Bank Stadium is strictly a non-smoking venue, and smoking is not permitted within any part of the stadium.

BAGS: Bags may be subject to a random safety and security search upon entry. Any prohibited items will be confiscated.

WEATHER: The concert will proceed rain or shine. Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance, so be prepared for either scenario.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE CONCERT

RECOMMENDED ROUTE: Patrons are strongly recommended to use public transport for the event, and all Transperth services are included with the ticket for 3 hours before and after the event. Catch the train to Claisebrook station and then walk 340 metres to ME Bank Stadium.

BUS SERVICES: The closest bus stops to the stadium are located on Lord St and Beaufort St. Normal scheduled services are as follows:

BUS SERVICES VIA LORD ST

Morley Bus Station - 46 and 48
Bassendean - 55
Bayswater - 41, 43 and 44
Maylands - 42

BUS SERVICES VIA BEAUFORT ST

Morley Bus Station - 21 and 22
Mirrabooka Bus Station - 67, 68 and 69

TRAIN SERVICES: There are four train stations within 1000 metres of the stadium: Claisebrook is 340 metres from Gate 4; Mclver Station is 600 metres from Gate 3; East Perth Station is 700 metres from Gate 1; and Perth Station is 1000 metres from Gate 3.

For this event the normal scheduled services will be augmented with a number of additional train services running. Visit www.transperth.wa.gov.au for more information.

TAXIS: The closest taxi rank is located near Gate 1 on Bulwer St and will be active at the conclusion of the concert.

ROAD CLOSURES: Road closures will be implemented from 3.30pm on Bulwer St, and from 9.30pm on Lincoln St, Brewer St, Summer St, Coolgardie Tce, Murchison Tce and Edwards St on the day of the concert.

PARKING FACILITIES: Street parking around ME Bank Stadium is limited, with most restricted to residents only. Parking is available at East Perth Rail Terminal (adjacent West Pde), Royal St, Central TAFE (Fielder St), Royal Perth Hospital (Moore St), Newcastle St, Pier St (on road south of Newcastle St only), William St near Newcastle St, Stirling St (on road south of Bulwer St only) and Brisbane St Car Park. Costs vary depending on the location.

DROP OFF/PICK UP POINT: A drop off/pick up point will be located on Brewer St, and can be accessed by turning off Lord St into Edwards St, then Pier St.

PROHIBITED:**

- Long chains or spikes of any nature
- Offensive weapons of any kind, bottles, poster tubes or containers of any nature
- Umbrellas, tarps and blankets
- Professional cameras (with detachable lenses), video cameras, or audio recorders with external microphones as well as digital recorders
- Any object that may be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, fireworks, etc
- Alcoholic beverages
- Illegal substances
- Cans and glass (containers, bottles, glasses etc)
- Flares and fireworks
- Loud hailers
- Umbrellas and sun/rain shelters
- Laser pointers
- Flagpoles over 1.5 metres in length
- Animals (guide dogs excepted)
- Articles displaying offensive or political messages
- Eskies, bags, prams and strollers that can not be stored underneath a standard venue seat (eskies not allowed in the general admission field areas)
- Any item, including musical instruments, deemed to be either a danger or nuisance to either yourself or others

** Please note that prohibited items will be confiscated. If in doubt, leave it at home or in your car.

PERMITTED:

- Small personal cameras and camera phones are allowed. Professional cameras with detachable lenses are not.
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sealed plastic bottles of water – the bottle cap will be removed upon entry.

FIXER/BACKSPACER FIELD GENERAL ADMISSION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Children under 18 years must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

Field Area is not recommended for children under 12 years.

Stadium terms and conditions of entry and restricted items apply.

Patrons must enter through the gate listed on their tickets.

Only Fixer Field patrons can move between Fixer Field and Backspacer Field. Backspacer patrons CANNOT enter the Fixer Field area.

Dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, stage diving, crowd surfing and climbing are not permitted.
