VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

BOX OFFICE: The box offices are located at the SFS Forecourt, Western perimeter and Eastern perimeter and will open from 3.30pm on the day of show only. However, to avoid queues on the day patrons are encouraged to collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketek outlet.

ENTRY GATES: Please refer to the gate letter printed on your ticket.

DISABLED ACCESS: Access to the wheelchair seating is via Gate A.

CLOAKROOM FACILITIES: Will not be available at this event and prohibited items may be confiscated, so if in doubt leave it in the car or at home.

PASS-OUTS: Will not be available, so ensure that you take everything that you require into the concert upon arrival.

FIRST AID: Will be available on site.

FOOD AND BAR FACILITIES: Will be available in and around the venue.

TOILETS: Are located at various positions in and around the stadium.

ATM/EFTPOS FACILITIES: There is limited ATM and EFTPOS access at the venue, so ensure that you come prepared with enough cash for the entire evening.

SMOKING: The SFS is strictly a no smoking venue.

BAGS: Bags may be subject to a random safety and security search upon entry. Any prohibited items will be confiscated.

WEATHER: The concert will proceed rain or shine. Only exceptionally severe weather conditions will affect the performance, so be prepared for either scenario.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE CONCERT

RECOMMENDED ROUTE: The easiest and best way to get to Moore Park for Pearl Jam is by public transport. Car parking near the venue is limited and will fill up early, so avoid the fuss and catch the bus!

The Moore Park Link Ticket offers return bus and train travel in one ticket. These tickets can be purchased at most City Rail Stations or for more information visit www.cityrail.info/event/moore_park.jsp.

Travel by train to Central Station, and then catch the express shuttle bus service from Chalmers Street direct to Moore Park.

You can catch the 339, 374, 376 or 391 Sydney Bus service from Eddy Avenue at Central Station direct to Moore Park.

Patrons can also take the ferry to Circular Quay and catch the 373, 392, 396, 397 or 399 bus services, which will operate from the Quay along Elizabeth Street in the City to Moore Park.

TAXIS: The nearest taxi rank is the permanent taxi rank located in the Entertainment Quarter on Errol Flynn Boulevard (opposite the Hordern Pavilion).

ROAD CLOSURES: The centre portion of Driver Ave will be closed on the day of the concert; access is from Moore Park Rd and the Eastern Distributor in the north, and Lang Rd via Anzac Pde in the south.

PARKING FACILITIES: Parking is located in MP2 in the Moore Park precinct, opposite SFS, off Driver Ave. The cost is \$15 if there are 4 or more people in the vehicle, and \$20 if there are 3 or less people in the vehicle.

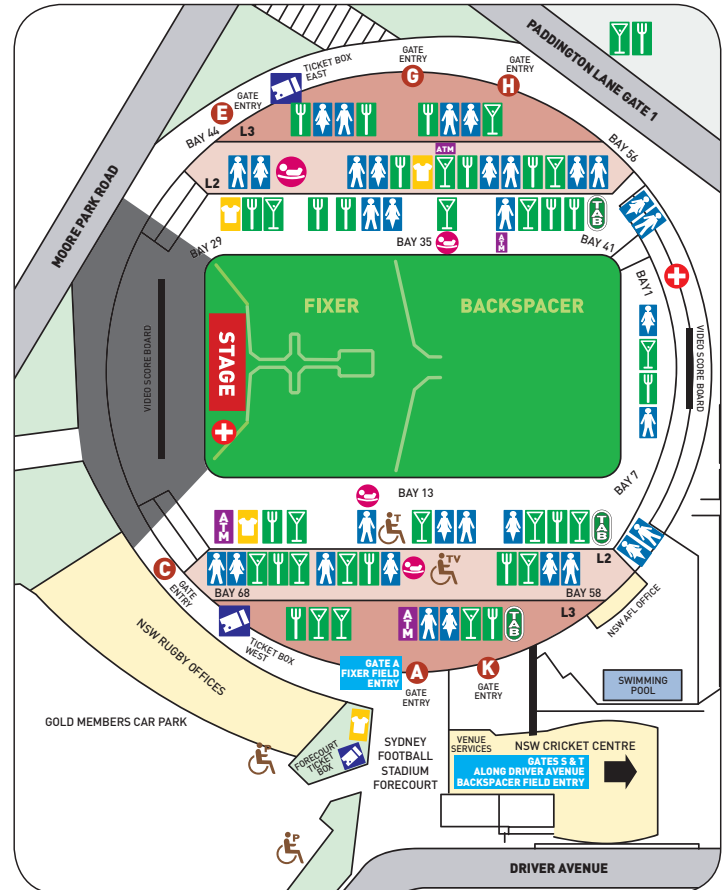
GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please note that conditions are subject to change without notice and may vary from event to event.

PROHIBITED**:

- Long chains or spikes of any nature
- Offensive weapons of any kind, bottles, poster tubes or containers of any nature
- Umbrellas, tarps and blankets
- Professional cameras (with detachable lenses), video cameras, or audio recorders with external microphones as well as digital recorders
- Any object that may be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, fireworks, etc
- Alcoholic refreshments
- Illicit drugs
- Flares or any other explosive device
- Glass bottles or breakable containers
- Offensive weapons (including knives and or guns)
- Metal containers, cans
- Skateboards, scooters, rollerblades or bicycles



- Dogs or other pets
- Large eskies (that cannot fit under a grandstand seat)
- Any flag poles over 1.5 metres in length
- Flags or banners over 1m x 1m in size
- Laser pointers
- Any item which, as deemed by the Sydney Cricket & Sports Ground Trust, can cause public nuisance or offence (musical instruments, whistles, horns and / or hooters) to any other patron in the venue.

** Please note that prohibited items will be confiscated. If in doubt, leave it at home or in your car.

PERMITTED:

- Small personal cameras and camera phones are allowed. Professional cameras with detachable lenses are not.
- Sun hat and sunscreen
- Jacket/poncho for inclement weather
- Sealed plastic bottles of water

FIXER/BACKSPACER FIELD – GENERAL ADMISSION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Alcohol is not permitted on the field for this event

Children 15 years and under must be accompanied by parent or guardian

Field area is not recommended for children under 12 years

Stadium terms and conditions of entry and restricted items apply

Patrons must enter through the gate listed on their tickets

Patrons cannot move between Fixer Field and Backspacer Field areas

Dangerous activities such as aggressive moshing, stage diving, crowd surfing and climbing are not permitted
